Yellow Polo with Logo




Royal Blue Shorts

***SHOES – Velcro Sneakers (No Lights, wheels or other "accessories")


*** SOCKS – White ankle/crew/athletic (above ankle bone) – can purchase anywhere

"Winter" (Oct. to April, 4 days/week)


Yellow Polo with Logo (same as summer – option of short sleeve or long sleeve)

Sweater Options – V-Neck Sweater, V-Neck Button Down Sweater, and/or V-Neck Sweater Vest, Navy Blue




**Black Shoes (Rubber soles, tie or close with Velcro), Black, Blue or White Socks (above ankle)

Black Shoes (Rubber soles, tie or close with Velcro – “Mary Jane” shoes with wide strap to keep shoe firmly on foot are also allowed) --- **NO ballet shoes or slip-on shoes

**Navy Blue knee socks or Navy Blue tights

Please make sure your child has the appropriate uniform as shown above. Kindergarten students will be permitted to wear the navy blue shorts as were worn in prekindergarten as they are “grand-fathered” in for this year as we transition to the royal blue shorts.

By the start of school, your child’s hair style must be appropriate for school, including:

- No designs, symbols or lines cut into hair
- No mohawks
- Hair is natural color (no highlighting, dyeing or bleaching)
- Hair cut to appropriate length and not blocking vision
